



## **TCC Radio | Listener's Script for Loved Ones**

### **Islam – January 2010**

The following Gospel conversation script is very similar to that used by our TCC Radio reps throughout the production of our series on Islam. It has been slightly edited to be used with personal loved ones.

---

Hi, <insert name>, I've been listening to a great radio show lately. They call themselves "a spiritual speaker's corner" because they talk openly about truth with people on the street and then broadcast the interviews on the air. It's a real eye-opener to hear the things people are thinking about and why!

Right now, they're asking people about the religion of Islam and they said listeners could be more involved and actually ask people they know the same sort of questions. Then when we listen to the show, we can sort of compare notes. Can I ask you a few?

1. How much do you know about the Muslim religion Islam?
2. Do you know that Muslims seek to serve the same God that the Jews followed?
3. Would you be surprised to learn that Muslims recognize the same Prophets that Christians do?
4. Based on these things, do you think that Muslims, Jews and Christians all pretty much believe the same thing?
5. The main question about these faiths is this; does God keep His word or not? If there was a God do you think He would keep His promises?

Gospel Bridge Question: Can I tell you very quickly why that question matters?

Points to consider:

- ✓ The Jews were told that God is a God of Justice and righteousness, and shown how mankind isn't at all like Him in these ways.
- ✓ The Jews were promised by God that He would judge all unrighteousness and that He would bring salvation from His Justice.
- ✓ So has God kept His word? Do you really need salvation, and if God has provided it how can you get it?

Share the Gospel! Here is a sample of what you might say:

*I guess the BIG question is this: Where will you spend eternity? The Bible says that the price of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus. So, how many times have you sinned? How many times have you lied, lusted, stolen, hated, used God's Name in vain? Because every time you have, you've sinned against Holy God, alienating yourself from Him – even your thinking is against Him. You will face the second death, which is eternity in the Lake of Fire!*

*But Jesus Christ paid for your sins, taking them and God's wrath against you, upon Himself. He shed His blood and died on the Cross in your place, and then He rose from the grave, defeating sin and death – just as the Scriptures foretold that He would! To be reconciled to God, you must repent (wake up!) to trust that Jesus died for your sins. Your sins will be forgiven and God will grant you eternal life. Then you can expect God to start truly changing you from the inside out, filling you with His abundant new life and purpose! Isn't that Good News?*
